sand pit for games and sports. The picnic shelter is the headquarters for all camp activities. Rainy day activities take place in the Youth Lounge in the Jewish Federation Building.

## What is a camp day like?

Every day campers enjoy many fun and educational programs and Chugim (activities) in a variety of areas such as arts, music, sports, nature, Jewish life, Israel and much more. Also we have swimming twice a week, a weekly field trip to a nature reserve or a park, Kabbalat Shabbat on Friday and many other trips and programs. Campers are carefully supervised at all times.
